**MATCHING GIFTS** is a corporate program that rewards an employee's charitable contributions. When an employee makes a donation to an eligible nonprofit, the employer "matches" the gift. Companies of all sizes match donations their employees make to nonprofits to support good work in their communities.

**WORKPLACE GIVING** is another way to make tax-deductible donations. Contributions are taken directly out of your paycheck at whatever amount you choose. Recurring donations are particularly helpful, because they help those organizations you care about focus their efforts where they are needed most.
